Kiwanis Education

What do all those titles mean and when do we use them? The most important title in Kiwanis is Kiwanian! Members are the most important part of the Kiwanis organization.

If you want to address a member of the club and are unsure if they have a past office – "Kiwanian ..." works!

If a member has held an office within the club, division or district we do attempt to recognize that <u>past service</u> by referring to their <u>most</u> recent past office.

The past offices are:

District level – Past Governor

Division level - Past Lieutenant Governor

Club level - Past President

Why for some members do we use the term Distinguished? Each year Kiwanis International sets a Distinguished Criteria that clubs use as a guide to a successful year. If the club meets the criteria and is awarded Distinguished Club, then the President is referred to as "Distinguished President June". The Distinguished award is presented after the Kiwanis year has ended therefore a distinguished president is a past president. We do not use both past and distinguished, just one or the other.
